



Winter Investiture Moot Report

December 10, 2017

Welcome from Their Alpine Highnesses Turk and Seamus:

Thank you all for coming to Investiture – it was a beautiful event and almost Standing Room Only.

Curia – *Piaras mac Toirdhealbhagh and Marcello Fornarius*

An update of the financial policy is in the works, and will be hopefully finished in time for March Coronet. Summits financial policy has been unclear regarding “comps” at Principality events. Following Kingdom examples, we’re clarifying the policies to match Kingdom:

- Gate fees (as opposed to feast, class, parking or other event charges) are the only fees that will be comped;
- Only holders of Great Offices will be automatically comped.

Local event stewards may propose additional comps within the constraints of their overall event budgets. If you have a Principality event coming up in the next year, per Financial Policy, a budget must be submitted to the Financial Committee for review and approval. Principality event budgets must be approved six months before the event, which means that budgets should be submitted as soon as possible for review. We would like to see Principality event budgets up to 18 months before the event. For some events, locking down a site early is important, so begin planning and submit budgets early.

We’ve added language to make Summits A&S and Bardic a Coronet event. This might be a good event for an officer meeting, brainstorming/planning session, or a moot – we will look at next year’s event to assess possibilities.

We removed the site charge for youth, so those under 18 will be admitted free to Principality events.

Regarding demos, the Principality has not historically done demos. The Principality Chatelaine’s Office budget is used to support local Chatelaines, and to provide the Moot breakfasts.

Summits Roll of Officers

Seneschal – *Piaras mac Toirdhealbhagh*

1. The application for my position has been open since September Coronet and I have not yet received any applications, though there have been a few individuals interested. Please do let me know if you have questions. If you wish to apply, please email the Kingdom Seneschal, myself, and Their Highnesses your modern and SCA resume and a cover letter (which may be the body of the email). I am hoping to sign someone on soon, so they can have plenty of time to learn the ropes.
2. I have completed the move to the new email so please use summitsseneschal@antir.org
3. There is a new seneschal warrant process that we're trying out – this may spread to other offices if it works

Calendar Deputy – *Kanavati*

1. The Calendar Deputy has no news to report.
2. The position is going well without too many hiccups.
3. The change to the new email caused a very short delay related to the submittal of two event EIF's.
4. The hope is to continue working towards being able to completely process and post to the kingdom event calendar, all principality events at the principality level. This continues to be a work in process.

Social Media Deputy – *vacant*

Bleu Grael Herald – *Berengaria de Montfort de Carcassonne*

1. I participated in the team working to prepare the Investiture ceremony for this weekend. The Hon. Lady Natasha did most of the writing and adapting; I just participated in the commenting & editing phases.
2. I answered queries about the Viscounty ceremony.
3. I am adapting the Silver Barberry ceremony at the request of His Excellency Seamus to what I feel is a better version to use going forward, not just at the time we have two Tanists. I plan to bring this up in the CRAVE (Companions of the Rose And Valorous Estate, proposed acronym courtesy of Vesta), to entreat the companions to listen & observe & see what they think of the adapted ceremony.
4. Proceeding from that, I am developing some items to take to that group to get input on a future version of the Viscounty ceremony; already, we have had some good suggestions, such as various members of the Orders acting as regalia bearers during the ceremony for a new member.
5. I am preparing to update the Summits Ceremonial to the next version; with the removal of the Order of the Wings of the Summits pursuant to the Coronet's decree, and the introduction of the Order of the Silver Chime ceremony, the document requires updating anyway. I hope to include the new Silver Barberry on a permanent basis, and am pursuing adapting other ceremonies, or writing the one or two that need adding. I also intend to improve the Investiture ceremony with the addition of some clarifying blocking, and some requested variations.

6. I completed my report to Black Lion via Demi-Lion. We had 100% reporting from the branches for this quarter which makes me happy!
7. I have targeted a few people who have expressed interest for learning specific skills – such as the herald of Myrtleholt, who wished to gain experience in field heraldry, and a herald from the coastal region of Terra Pomaria, who wishes to learn court heraldry.

Chancellor of the Exchequer – *Marcello Fornarius*

1. Third quarter reports were all on time! The Summits funds are growing steadily and spending has been kept to a minimum. The budget approved amount for a new exchequer computer has not been used, but I will be exploring options to update the computer in the near future.
2. I am meaning to do book reviews with local Exchequers; I will figure out how to get to everyone. Also, I will be looking at officer budgets, so if you need more money for your office, let me know.

Chamberlain – *Diana de Winterton*

1. We accomplished a great switchover of the trailer – we've had lots of good input regarding regalia, and now we have a new kneeling pillow. If anyone wants to do help with new regalia, let me know.
2. His Highness Seamus would like to decommission the current Alpine Scholar robes; we will look at them and come up with ideas.
3. I am creating a list of regalia for each office, so if you have any information, please let me know.
4. CRAVE has a box for tea supplies now stored in the Principality trailer.

Minister of Arts & Sciences – *Rowan SpiritWalker*

1. All reports were in on time, with the exception of Southmarch, which did not submit a report this quarter. I have discussed the issue with Southmarch's Seneschal, who has graciously offered to report in the future until the issue is solved.

Chronicler – *Aoibheall an Sionnach*

1. The new chronicler email (summitschronicler@antir.org) has been implemented and is working well, and I am looking forward to the day when all the Summits officer emails are up and running.
2. More event stewards are sending their event notices in on time, and I thank the branch seneschals for helping make that happen.
3. A particular shout-out to Lady Solbella haTayeret, the Coeur du Val seneschal, who provided a complete 3rd quarter report on behalf of their new officer, enabling me to get my report completed and in on time.
4. Communication with branches - A number of branch Chronicler changes only came to light when I made the final call for 3rd quarter reports. Seneschals, please send me a copy of the warrant when a new Chronicler is installed. I want to work with you to make sure your Chroniclers have access to resources they need.

5. I continue to look for ways to make the Chronicler's position meaningful and useful to the larger community. I believe that we will need to assess and develop a number of different communication platforms in the coming years (FB, Twitter, Instagram, et al), and I hope to find a deputy who has a broader/deeper understanding of those technologies.

Chatelaine – *Svala Picti*

1. Not much to report.
2. Still having issues getting into emails.
3. I'm sure reports for the officers are in there.
4. I'll know more when I meet with the Webminister this weekend.

Gryphon Scribe – *Diana de Winterton*

1. There has been lots of activity with charters as well as folks doing Kingdom stuff – I'm not hearing a lot about scribal stuff on the local level.
2. I have been organizing the office archives, and am putting together a log of past charters. We also have a lot of original charters with old borders, left over from previous reigns, so we are looking to reuse those and keep our traditions.

Family Activities Coordinator – *Ulf the Wanderer*

1. I am now using the new e-mail through Office 365.
2. Things are going slowly as I figure out how the principality FAC office works.
3. By the next tourney season, I am hoping to see family activities and YAFA classes all over the lands in the Summits.
4. Because the Principality position sat empty for some time, we don't have an accurate list of the local FACs, so please help.

Minister of the Lists – *Acacia Gryffyn*

1. Lists happened at Coronet. I wasn't there. From what I heard it went well (other than the shield board breaking...). It will be repaired or remade by the Chamberlain's office.
2. My term is up in June (how did THAT happen???) so we should advertise for applicants. I would love to require any applicants to help at Coronet so they know if they want it. And if no one applies I'm willing to extend my term.
3. I am still struggling to get folks to pre-reg. I'm not sure what the answer is....other than requiring it?
4. We had a little over 50% prereg for the Captain of Cats tournament. I asked those who didn't why not, and got a lot of good ideas. Please help promote preregistration for lists, as it makes everything move faster and easier.

Earl Marshal – *Sverre Bjornhjarda*

1. We had a successful year of tournaments, with minimal injury and other issues. We look forward to a continuation of this in the next year.
2. There will be some updated armor inspection standards that will require every heavy fighter to be aware of and to be patient as we educate the marshals.

3. There's a 1-1/2-year-old helmet standard we never implemented; everything after the 1st of year will require ½ inch padding, and must be checked every single tournament.
4. Some older fighters are coming back with brain trauma because of 30 years of fighting, so we are going to be very strict going on.
5. New rules also state we can't have internally-placed bars on helmets unless they are structurally sound and even overbuilt. There have been cases of helmet bars failing in wars, causing critical damage.
6. A broken chin strap at An Tir-West War might have been a factor that led to stroke – we should be very careful about all parts of helmet
7. At Viscountess Temperance's suggestion, Sverre will develop and teach classes for fighters on how to evaluate and inspect their own gear. This will be developed by Coronet.

Archery Deputy – *Tryggr Tyresson*

1. The end of archery season was Oct. 31, except for indoor. There is archery taking place in lots of branches but not all of them are reporting. Some branches have the possibility of doing archery (warranted people in the branch) but are not running and/or reporting it. If you are doing archery, you need to take care of the paperwork.
2. There is a list of warranted marshals on line, and Tryggr will be happy to come train. Remember that once a range has been inspected and approved by a senior marshal, a junior marshal can run practices.

Summits Hunter (Thrown Weapons) – *William Cristofer*

If you need TW marshals trained, help getting ranges going, or help with thrown weapons at events, let me know.

Rapier Deputy – *Iurii Victorev Belogorski*

1. From Alail: I would like to thank all who have helped make my term as Rapier Deputy for the Summits enjoyable and a success.
2. We had 20 people compete in the Captain of Cats Tournament.
3. I am interested in talking about marshallate standards for the Principality.

Cut & Thrust Deputy – *Taran destingr*

1. C&T is going very strong in the Summits; we are leading the way in An Tir and the Society as a whole. There are C&T fighters in many of the branches, and we would all like to see more.
2. Taran and Faradoch (Kingdom C&T Marshal) will travel throughout the Summits to promote C&T – training, marshalling, helping with events; they're willing to make the trek, so please contact them.

Equestrian Deputy – *Anna von Engelberg (outgoing)*

1. After 6 years of this office in one household, it's time to allow someone else to take up the reins, as it were. At this time, no senior marshal has expressed interest in serving as the PEO. While I will no longer hold the title of Summits Equestrian Officer, both Sir

William and I are absolutely willing to help out in any way we can (within monetary reason!) if a group is interested in the equestrian activities. My home email is nancy@troygriffith.com

2. Challenges: We are in a lull in the Principality as a whole regarding Equestrian Activities. Terra Pomaria continues its enjoyment of horses in the SCA.
3. Upcoming Events: Terra Pomaria will again be hosting an Equestrium (learning about horses in the SCA: general knowledge of horses, riding, the games, mounted combat and jousting, how one can be involved even if they don't own a horse, etc.) This will be the first weekend in June at Stonehenge Farms in Aumsville, OR. COME JOIN US!
4. The Outrider competition is still in stasis.

War Lord of the Summits – *Ivan Shield Bane*

1. Well given the holidays things have been slow.
2. We did a small war practice last month In Klamath
3. I'm gearing up for after the new year getting back on track I'm talking to people about getting a Central Summits practice going but have to get the place nailed down.
4. Art of War is in April

Youth Armored Combat Deputy – *vacant*

Webminister – *Suvia filia Hereberti*

1. Kingdom has sent the most recent set of email addresses and logon information. I've sent info to all but Herald, Rapier, Briar oak Exchequer, Myrtle Holt seneschal, and Tymberhavene exchequer who have not contacted me.
2. I have updated the Officers of State listing page with the most current addresses.
3. If you need help setting up your Principality email, I am happy to work with you. Most branch Seneschals and Exchequers have moved over, and I am going to try to get more of the branch officers on the system. This is a great way to share documents, and it gives us the ability to archive and have continuity through office transitions.
4. I am slowly getting the website updated. Kingdom is looking at moving all websites into new platform in 2018, and I am waiting for that.
5. My term is up in September.
6. Briar oak is still having issues getting into their website.

Upcoming Championships

Alpine Scholar - A&S & Bardic 2018 (February) – *Berengaria de Montfort de Carcassonne*

1. For my position as Alpine Scholar, I have:
 - a. Taken note of the publication of event information by Viscountess Ekaterina, the event steward, and made plans to ensure that I get there come snow or fog or freezing hail;
 - b. Recruited teachers; I have Maestra Elsbeth & Maestra Sarre of Reannag Teine committed to come over to teach tile painting and another class, for starters;
 - c. Communicated with Tanist Seamus about his plans for the event and his tenure.

2. I have received one letter of intent so far, and I am planning on doing a reminder campaign and extending the deadline to the end of the year.
3. Suvia says there will be a 2-hour Laurel meeting on Sunday morning of AS&B
4. The event is using the Kingdom rubric for judging.

Bard of the Summits - A&S & Bardic 2018 (February) – *Iurii Victorev Belogorski*

1. In October, I taught a storytelling class at Amergin's, and I judged a bardic tournament.
2. At Samhain, I organized and ran a bardic tournament. Cormac Mor was the winner.
3. In October, the Shire of Glyn Dwfn began organizing regular bardic nights. By Investiture, the Shire had carried out 3 bardic nights.
4. For the Bardic Championship, I am not requiring letters of intent so as to encourage folks to participate. It will be in Bardic circle style, pick-pass-and-play, with competitors mixed with those not competing. Also there will be a “never won a bardic” tournament and a “single entry for critique” option in the same competition. Please prepare three entries, two for the main competition and one for finals. I am not planning bardic classes, but Viscountess Temperance will do an “Intro to Shakespeare” class at the event.

Captain of Tigers - March Coronet 2018 (March) – *Bowen Doyle*

1. Format for the tourney will be a round Robin, with the top 4 fighters going into a single elimination tourney, with the finals being best 2 out of 3.
2. I would like to use the shield boards but will not make shield board or banners a requirement. They are however encouraged.

Summits Defender - Summer Investiture 2018 (June) – *Keith the Wanderer*

1. We are talking about doing matched 2-handed weapons tournament, per event steward

Branch Seneschals

Adiantum – *William Jakes*

1. Midwinters is coming up, and we will have Sergeant trials in April.
2. *From Sverre Bjornhjarda*– There’s no Grand Thing on the calendar this year, so Egil’s may see more people than last year. Please reserve camping space as early as possible, since space will be very, very tight. We are having landmaster reservations open after the 1st of year. We really need volunteers to help with everything.
3. We’re looking at combining Martinmas and Amergins with Terra Pomaria so we can remove a few events from the calendar and encourage more people to come to events.

Briaroak – *Sleibhin O’leannachain*

1. Things are continuing to go well for Briaroak. After a long, extended term, our A&S minister, Brian Brown, has stepped down and Jennaty Gaedecke has stepped up to take his place. She has jumped in with both feet, not only planning some excellent classes but also including a period recipe with each class.
2. Our Chronicler took on the task of getting a new shire website built and has brought our shire newsletter, The Briarpatch, back to life.

Coeur du Val – *Solbella haTayeret*

1. We have no events planned yet. Lebus is starting to be discussed for August, and we are playing with the idea of helping with a Crown event.
2. We are going through some minor changes in officers and are hoping to host some great workshops to get more heavy and rapier marshals.
3. After 3 mailing attempts, Kingdom has finally gotten our Linn County polling forms! We're waiting patiently for a response.
4. Otherwise, we seem to be running smoothly!

Corvaria – *Tighearnan Cearrbhach o'Faolain*

1. On December 2nd, the Shire welcomed in the season by participating in the Bend Christmas parade. We had 12 participants garbed and walking the parade with banners and decorated carts. We got a warm response, and Tryggr entertained the crowd in his armor. Though we started late putting things together, we did well with the limited planning. We will be putting this on our calendar for 2018 and assigning a planning committee to make our future participation larger and more impressive.
2. We have our Shire Yule feast coming up on December 16th. All are welcome, although we understand winter travel can be difficult. There is no site fee, a \$15 feast fee (please RSVP and arrange payment ASAP if you would like to partake), and offboard seating for those who wish to join us but wish to bring their own.
3. We have plans in the works for all of our 2018 events, and we are assembling our team for March Coronet 2019, assuming we are still scheduled to host it.
4. My biggest goals for 2018 are:
 - a. Continue improvement of Shire organization and increase planning horizons and time for our events.
 - b. Continue our fruitful recruitment efforts.
 - c. Get involved in the local colleges.
 - d. Increase our presence and profile in the community.
5. Though our membership numbers are at a low ebb, I can see an upswing in the works, as we have a number of true newcomers being trained up, have been contacted by a few members who are relocating here in the first half of the year, and anticipate a few familiar faces returning after absences.
6. Our biggest challenge is expanding our pool of possible officers: both our Exchequer and Chatelaine have warrants expiring by the end of December, and we have few ready to step into those roles and others. For now Tryggr will take over as Exchequer (with Laurencia serving as Deputy until someone else qualified is ready). Laurencia has agreed to lead the compilation of our Doomesday report, so that Tryggr is not thrown into the pool on the deep end.
7. Any assistance in arranging officer training for any and all roles is welcome.

Glyn Dwfn – *Kathren of Carnforth*

1. The major update for our branch is that Glyn Dwfn is starting to look at a preliminary interest polling for baronial status. I have reached out to the Kingdom's new branches deputy and Summits Seneschal for help with this process.

2. We have also decided not to hold Hocktide next year and instead to move Tain Bo to May.
3. The major challenge we are facing is trying to find a bank that is easier to work with. Our exchequer has been doing a great job of working on this.

Myrtle Holt – *Keara Buchanan*

1. Myrtleholt is doing really good; we have just had Investiture and hopefully it has been a success.
2. We are planning our Hogmanay Feast the first Saturday of January.
3. We have had some discussion regarding demos and the such, and we are looking into doing two demos that we have not done in quite a long time, and one we haven't done at all, in fact.
4. Our bank account is good; I don't have an exact total for you at this time due to all the feast preparations and site preparations.
5. We have a person who is stepping up to be our Exchequer Deputy, so we now have an Exchequer Deputy as well as our Seneschal Deputy as well as the other offices that we have filled at this point.

Southmarch – *Arkadii L'vovich*

1. The Autumn has been pleasant in Southmarch. Our Frostbite Tourney event was decently attended.
2. The Shire is preparing for next February's A&S&B championship.
3. We have an upcoming (external) fundraiser in January as well.
4. Our officers roster remains unchanged. Our deputy Exchequer is poised to take over for the current one when her warrant expires at the end of this month.

Terra Pomaria – *Gwyneth Blackthorne*

1. I am still actively seeking my successor. I have two individuals, HL Morikawa Kenji Katashige and Lord Wystan Albryght, who have mentioned an interest in the position. I am in talks with both of them about job requirements and benefits. I am hoping to have a definite successor in place well before Bar Gemels so that when I step down in Fall of 2018 it will be a smooth transition.
2. I have been working with Antonius Rath of Adiantum to combine the Terra Pomaria event of Martinmas with Adiantum's Amergins in 2018 per His Highness Durin's directive at the Seneschal training. The combined event will not only clear one calendar weekend, but we believe that it will also result in higher attendance and less stress on each branch. I had hoped to combine our Long and Short of It with Coeur Du Valle's Lebus, but they have declined.

Tymberhavene – *Yrmegard de Groet*

1. We will have a Seneschal changeover happening within the next week or so. Randwulf (Phil Slaughter) is stepping into the role. I will be moving over to Exchequer as our current one has been swamped by modern life.

2. We're still only having success with A&S in the Shire, but that is going strong. We're continuing to try to get people excited and doing other things. Maybe the change in seneschal will help.
3. There will be no War in the Trees this year, since we are doing Investiture.

Upcoming Coronet & Principality Events

Winter Investiture 2017 - Myrtle Holt

1. Victor de Guers is our new Captain of Cats.
2. Receipts (estimated) – Our event costs were roughly \$1050. We had 139 people thru gate (including 17 comps). Our total gate take was around \$2240, leaving a profit of around \$1200. Vesta will have more accurate numbers later.

A&S & Bardic 2018 - Southmarch

1. Champions are asked to get their competition details to Ekaterina as soon as possible, and to post the details.
2. The event will be held on February 2/9-11 at the Shilo Inn. Get a room and come have fun.

March Coronet 2018 - Terra Pomaria

1. The preregistration form is being worked on by Sindri and Melanie. Melanie has a list of all cabins with beds and things along with ADA access.
2. We have a prereg person, a gate person, lists is taken care of, fencing is handled, the tourney is taken care of, Captain of Tigers is taken care of, chatelaine-moot-Curia taken care of, merchants classes and class back up, YAFA, other children's activities.
3. Cabins have different numbers of beds, so you will be plugged in where you fit. If you want to be in a cabin with another person, prereg with them.
4. There are not a lot of food options in Turner, so plan accordingly.
5. We still need help with decorating, auctions, A&S display, actual schedule and planning meetings for Ladies of the Rose and Valorous Estate, Laurels, Pelicans, Marshals of Defense, Chivalry. The Space is reserved – we just need contact info and time requirements.
6. We have in our possession 160 yards (I think) of 72" wide very thick paintable black polyester fabric that was gifted to me to use as whatever...we can use it to cover some of the ugly.
7. Pictures went up of the insides and we did a partial walk through. Websites are being updated; next is copy for Echoes and Crier. We will start listing out more info after 11th Night.
8. Fighting will be indoors, not insulated, footing is carpet – requirements are in the Echoes and on Website. Bring your best format. Shield boards are required, as is item of largesse; Requiring banner for fighter and/or consort, want to hang them on walls after procession
9. The event will be held at the Oregon Christian Convention center in Turner.

June Investiture 2018 - Tymberhavene

1. Site is reserved and paid for, and the budget has been approved. We'll be at West Laverne Park which has showers, RV sites, and flush toilets. RV sites cost us extra, so that won't be comped (\$15/wknd).
2. Ongoing conversations are happening with Seamus and Turk about what they would like to happen.
3. Friday night soup & bread will still be provided by the Shire.
4. The site has limited cell phone reception
5. Gate, etc will be worked out as we get closer. We're on track.
6. Unless Summits Warlord tells different, Banner Bearer tournament will be held on Sunday.
7. Please pre-reg.
8. Their Majesties are planning to attend – (not official)
9. The MOD would like to do an invitational tournament then.

Fall Coronet 2018 - Adiantum

1. Rath: Evan and I are waiting to get parking issues at the former Amergins site approved. The financial committee should get everything for approval in January. We are still working on a few logistical things.

Winter Investiture 2018 - Briaroak

1. We will be putting together a team for this event very soon.

West-An Tir War Committee – we are always looking for help! The war now has a permanent Facebook page; we're trying to come up with new ways to improve the war with things we've learned from GWW. We want to have pre-reg up close to the 1st of year. Merchant applications will be out at 12th Night. Marcello will ask about PayPal system at 12th Night.

Improving Communications

1. Principality Officers need to move over to the new email so all future emails are in one place. Make sure all of your deputy officers have the email and ask them to send a test email so it's in their (and your) Contacts list!
2. If someone is not reporting, or you don't know who is in a specific office in the branch, contact Piaras so he can work with the seneschal there to get the information and pass on the message.
3. There are some concerns about the online event calendar – the real information is often not on the Kingdom calendar or the Principality webpage. Some are simply providing a link to the Facebook event, which makes it difficult to find all the information.
4. Please use the Echoes to promote your events. Update your event copy with additional details as the date comes closer, and put it in multiple issues.
5. David de Rosier-Blanc will be teaching an event steward class at Briaroak Birl in February to educate folks on these communication options.

Future Principality Moots

Apart from updates on Officers and Principality Events, what are things the populace want to see happen and discussed at Principality Moot when time allows?

What are some ways to increase participation in Principality Moots?

- Have evening moot, when that is feasible
- Create a way for officers to distribute reports before Moot, so we can have time to discuss other things. Officers might attach a “moot summary” to their quarterly reports, so the moot agenda could be compiled early and distributed.
- Once the Kingdom moves to its new system, then we can look at developing an online reporting system. The current structure doesn’t support that.

Bids for 2018 Captain of Eagles and Summits Hunter

We decided at the last moot to hold the Captain of Eagles and the Summits Hunter Championships at the same event, preferably a preexisting archery event. Bids are now open for the 2018 event! Please review the Principality requirements for the Captain of Eagles Championship, as the same will apply for both. The bid form is on the website. Please have the bid in by A&S and Bardic Championship, for a decision by March Coronet.

Crown events

Seamus – I would like to see more Crown events in Summits.
