### **Hogmanay Scottish-Celtic New Years**

January 04, 2014

Step back in time 500 years with us to the year 1514, and join us for a traditional Scottish New Year Feast. As has become tradition, the Shire of Myrtleholt will be hosting the traditional Scottish new year, and this year in grand style. This year, we will be celebrating at the Kerby Belt Building, the traditional home of this event from years past.

Daytime activities will include :

ARTS AND SCIENCES ACTIVITIES

Competitions: A&S competition for best period youth garb.  
Extra points will be awarded for Documentation , youth modeling and presentation.

**MARTIAL ACTIVITIES:**

Heavy and Rapier Fighting:

Myrtleholt's first ever Heavy and Rapier Tournament of men who stare at goats.

Rules will be as follows: On the Eric there will be on opposite sides an impaled goat's head.

The fighters will be asked to take their positions with their helm on the goat heads.

At "lay on", they will have to spin around the goat's head 10 times, while counting, and then proceed to engage their most honorable (dizzy) opponent. If you reach your opponent and they are still spinning, death from behind rules will apply. Other than taking a leg, if the fighter goes to the ground the fight is over. As if this isn't fun enough; we will be recruiting the help of our spectators. They will be asked to bring one type of farm animal (of the stuffed variety) to throw, once per fight, at the combatant of there choosing. At the end of the competition, a victor will be announced, who will be given the prize of a "Golden Fleece" with which to adorn themselves.

Highland Games: stone throw, caber toss and (back by popular demand) the sheep toss.

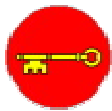
