Unto the populace of the Summits Greetings,

The requirements and conventions for Fall Coronet Tournament are as follows:

1. A written Request for Permission to fight in Summits' Fall Coronet Tournament, including the name of the combatant and the consort, must be submitted to TAH. This missive may be submitted one of three ways:
  - a. E-mail (date and time stamped no later than midnight, Sunday, August 4, 2013)
  - b. Snail-mail (post marked Saturday, August 3, 2013)
  - c. Hand-delivered at Briaroak Bash.
2. A formal Letter of Intent must be submitted by snail-mail (post-marked no later than August 16, 2013) or delivered by-hand to TAH at either Harvest Tournament or Sport of Kings.
3. TAH will speak individually with each combatant and consort at the Social, Friday night of Coronet Tournament or no later than 9am Saturday of Coronet Tournament.
4. Day of Tournament: A. Fighter w/Membership Card & Fighter Authorization Card B. Consort w/ Membership Card C. Individual Shield Board for use on the List Board D. (Optional) Banners
5. List Conventions: Bring Your Best
6. Finals Conventions: TBA
7. Combatants' Tournament Shield Standards: Maximum - 31" round, 22" x 28" Heater
